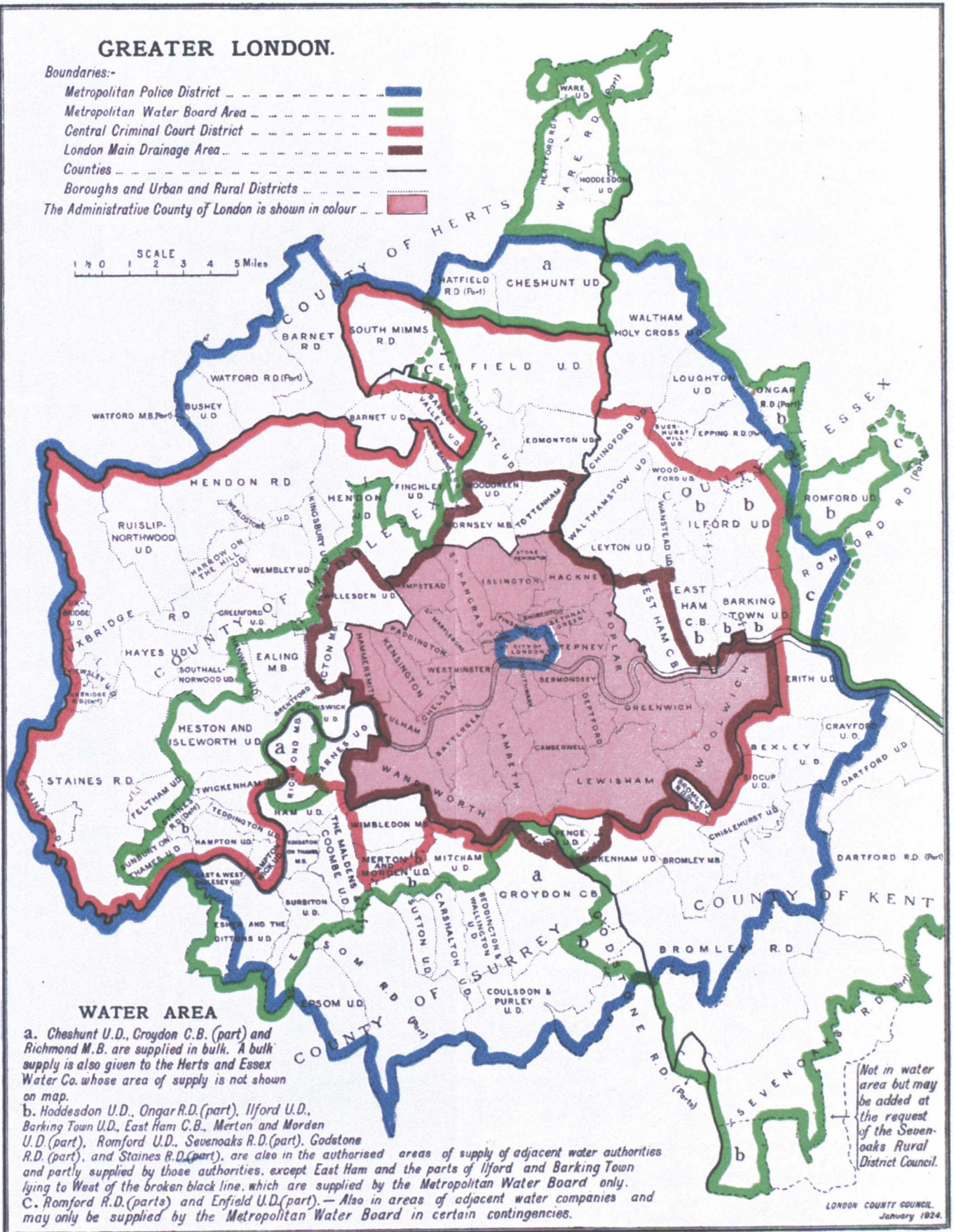


# GREATER LONDON.

## WATER AREA

a. Cheshunt U.D., Croydon C.B. (part) and Richmond M.B. are supplied in bulk. A bulk supply is also given to the Herts and Essex Water Co. whose area of supply is not shown on map.

b. Hoddesdon U.D., Ongar R.D. (part), Ilford U.D., Barking Town U.D., East Ham C.B., Merton and Morden U.D. (part), Romford U.D., Sevenoaks R.D. (part), Godstone R.D. (part), and Staines R.D. (part), are also in the authorised areas of supply of adjacent water authorities and partly supplied by those authorities, except East Ham and the parts of Ilford and Barking Town lying to West of the broken black line, which are supplied by the Metropolitan Water Board only.

c. Romford R.D. (parts) and Enfield U.D. (part).— Also in areas of adjacent water companies and may only be supplied by the Metropolitan Water Board in certain contingencies.
